Bio: Polly Tommey is a successful actress, author, editor, and now producer of two powerful documentaries. She is also the mother of three beautiful children, one of whom was severely injured by the MMR vaccine. That experience inspired Polly to become one of the most powerful voices today trying to understand who and what is poisoning our children and what we can do to keep our children safe and healthy.

C. Austin Fitts: Ladies and gentlemen, it is my pleasure to welcome to *The Solari Report* Polly Tommy, who is the executive producer of *Vaxxed II*, which is the sequel to *Vaxxed*. If you remember, *Vaxxed* was the *Documentary of the Year* on *The Solari Report* in 2016. Polly, in addition to having a very successful career in media, is an author and editor, and she is the producer of these two great documentaries.

She is also the mother of an autistic child, and is very, very passionate about this. What is that noise I hear?

Polly Tommey: We have chickens running around, and I can't really get away from them. I'm sorry, but we live on a farm.

Fitts: That's great! I normally live in Hickory Valley, Tennessee, so I understand the problem! Usually, behind me, are cows that make the noise and the dogs that herd them.

With that, Polly, welcome to *The Solari Report*. Thank you for joining us, and congratulations on an incredible sequel to *Vaxxed* with *Vaxxed II*.

Tommey: Thank you for having me. I have to say that an outstanding team put that film together, and I am grateful to them.

Fitts: There are two things that I want to accomplish with this conversation. One is that I want everybody to get *Vaxxed II* and watch it. As we start, let's talk about how we find the website, how we get the DVD, and how we stream *Vaxxed II* online.

Tommey: On that note, because of censorship – which is being so strong with *Vaxxed II: The People's Truth*-we had a much better run with *Vaxxed I* because being thrown out of the Tribeca Film Festival. They gave us free publicity, but they wised up now. We can't really stream anyway unless you go to <u>www.VaxxedII.com</u>. You will be able to stream it there and see other stories and get DVDs.

If you have a Roku television and you want to watch *Vaxxed II* on your television, pull up the channel Peeps TV and you will see *The People's Truth*, and you will also see all the stories from the road that we recorded. With *Vaxxed II*, we could only take a few of the stories, but there are thousands and thousands of stories on every single vaccine. So if you have a Roku television, that is the best place to go. Just pull up Peeps TV, and you will see all our work.

Fitts: Great, and your son was the producer. The process of having to become your own media, turned you into a media conglomerate!

Tommey: My son, Toby, was at college. When I was driving around in the bus, I called him and said, "Toby, you have to leave college, and need to drive this bus; I need a bus driver."

He said, "Mom! How many other mothers would call their child up and say, Get out of college and drive a bus'?"

I said, "Toby, this is the best education you will ever see."

Fitts: They did an incredible job.

Let me take you back to the screenings that occurred after Tribeca exploded the media attention to *Vaxxed*. You were on the road, started to go around with the *Vaxxed* team to do panel discussions after the screenings, and decided to buy a bus. Begin there, and tell us how this happened.

Tommey: It was incredible. I don't think Andy Wakefield, Del Bigtree, or myself were prepared for the number of parents who were forming lines after the film for the three of us- after the Q&A – to tell us their stories. It was overwhelming.

All three of us knew that the world needed to hear them. That is when we started going live. At least, I started going live, and Andy and Del went into the science of it. That became too much, and I couldn't do the stories because there wasn't enough time to do stories, and we were wasting so much time flying and waiting in airports.

I said to Del, who happened to be traveling with us, "We have to get a bus, and we have to be on the ground with the parents, and travel to their homes and wherever they want us to be."

So, we got this rickety old bus from one of the people, Sheila Ealey, who is in the first film. She gave us her old family bus. We got on the road, and it was incredible, and it is still incredible.

Fitts: So, *Vaxxed* focused on vaccine injuries related to the MMR (measles, mumps and rubella) vaccine. But when you went on the road, you started interviewing thousands of parents who were showing up. You discovered that the problem was much bigger than you had understood. Tell us about your education in listening to the parents.

Tommey: My passion has always been the MMR because my son had the MMR when he was 13 months old, and that was what injured him. So, I didn't really think about the other vaccines; I just knew that I was never going to vaccinate my children again and that the MMR was a problem.

So, when we went out on the road, after a couple of days in, we got our first Gardasil story. That really shook us. This girl was telling us exactly what happened to her. We had this entire new generation with this whole new Gardasil HPV (human papillomavirus vaccine usually given to females ages 11 to 26), and people are able to tell us their stories, whereas the babies of this world who were injured, can't tell us what happened to them; they can't even formulate that.

Then we did the Gardasil story live, and lines of the Gardasil vaccinated youths came out, and it became the biggest story of all. Everywhere we went there was a Gardasil story.

Then we got our first dead baby story, which horrified us. None of us even thought for a second that SIDS was heavily related – as reported by the parents – to vaccine injury and death. The minute that we did our first dead baby story, they all started coming in. It was as though the world was waking up to every single vaccine.

This bus was the place to go and tell your story because these parents, like myself, had no way of getting out what had happened to us. And I have to say that every single parent who came to that bus to tell their story was doing it because they were trying to warn other people; they were not doing it because they wanted compensation or to make their lives any better. Literally, a group of thousands – if not millions worldwide – were trying to warn other parents not to go through this.

Fitts: You can tell they were terrified that it might happen to another parent what happened to them.

Tommey: I have never seen so much pain. I didn't even know that this kind of pain was in this world – the pain of the parents who lost their children or their children were severely brain-damaged. You can see in their eyes that their soul is just weeping; it's terrible; it's horrific; it's barbaric.

Fitts: I was following you as the bus was going around. I was watching the videos that you would post. One of the things that would happen was you would see with these parents, many of whom would have to stay isolated in their home taking care of children, that you would have them on Periscope. I want you to tell everybody what Periscope is. Then you would point out all the hearts of people expressing their connection with them, and you could see the terrible relief they felt on suddenly not being alone. It was astonishing.

Tommey: Basically, we started going out on Periscope, which is called Peeps TV, and it is at *Vaxxed II* if you want to join us.

What happened was I would get a story, and I would press the 'live' button, and the world would join in. Literally, people from around the world would get a notification that I was going live, and they would see the story at exactly the same time that I was seeing the story.

What these families started doing was feeling that they had either been through the stories themselves, or they had the same situation, but the love that was going around the world to the person sitting on the bus telling their story was incredible. They would do it by sending these hearts. I just had to show these people how much they were loved, and it made such a difference. Everybody was almost giving one big group hug, and it was like they were saying, "We know what you are going through, we know your pain, and we are here for you."

Fitts: One of the things that parents have experienced – and I have seen this for many years, and I saw it with my clients – was by the government and by the media and by the healthcare industry and by the pharmaceutical industry. There was incredible bullying and gaslighting of parents, even enforcement blaming them for the deaths or the injury.

If you look at what has been done to these parents: One is the terrible harm of the vaccine injury to the child and the family and the parents, but then there is the second harm of insisting that this is not really happening.

Tommey: The level of bullying to these parents is unbelievable. The bullying starts when you question a vaccine. That is when it starts. The number of parents who would tell us the terrible things that the pediatricians would say, "If you don't have this vaccine, your child will die. If you don't have this vaccine, you will die of cancer. That is going to happen."

That is where it starts, and out of fear, people who weren't going to vaccinate then get vaccinated. After you have your injury or the baby dies, the parents reported police, and they were treated as though they were the ones who killed that baby, and from there on their family members treat them differently. If anybody says, "My baby died from a vaccine," they would say, "The baby had the vaccine a couple of days ago," and the family members, as well as the online trolls, would say terrible things.

All the Gardasil girls are being told, "It's all in your head. You are making this up. You are doing it for attention." And on and on it goes.

Of course, we all know how the parents are treated with autistic children. The bullying is huge, and it just adds to the pain.

Fitts: One of the things that I want everybody to do is watch the documentary, and at the end, I'm going to ask Polly how we can support her. But we want to see this get as much support as possible. You need to watch it.

The thing that made *Vaxxed* a world-class documentary is that you radiate the sense that you are unbelievably curious to get to the bottom of what is really happening, and you absolutely believe that the way to get to the facts is to listen to the thousands of parents, and you are deeply interested in every one of their stories. There is no feeling that you have a theory of what is going on and you are going to impose that theory. You only want to hear story after story, and are truly inspired, caring, and interested to hear the truth. It radiates through the whole documentary.

You seem to know that this was the pathway; to listen to the parents.

Tommey: I have always been passionate about the parents, and here is why. When I took my child in to get vaccinated, I totally trusted the white coat medical professionals. It didn't even occur to me that could be a problem because, if there was going to be a problem, they would have told me about it. So, having gone through that experience with them and having the doctors say, "You are crazy" was unreal. My doctor even said that maybe John and I needed psychiatric help in thinking that it was the vaccines.

So having been through that, I knew that the parents weren't being listen to. On the road with those lines that went on forever and ever, we did not leave until we had finished that last story. Sometimes it was one or two in the morning because every parent deserves their story to be told.

Fitts: That's amazing, and those lines were so long!

Tommey: I know. Sadly, some parents couldn't wait. We had just gotten back from Utah, and there was snow there. Parents were waiting for four hours in the freezing snow, and their children were severely autistic, and they had to go. That broke our hearts because we couldn't go any faster than we were. We really need hundreds of buses in every single state taking these stories because we have only scratched the surface. There is much more injury out there.

Fitts: One of the most life-changing videos I have ever watched came from those interviews, and it is in *Vaxxed II*; the McDowell triplets. Do you want to tell us a little about the McDowell triplets?

Tommey: They came to the bus, and we didn't know who they were. They sat on the bus, and did the most powerful interview that we have ever done. It is very interesting because so many people say, "I'm just going to go with a delayed schedule."

They went for a delayed schedule. When you watch *Vaxxed II*, you will see that is what they did. They only had the pneumococcal vaccine that day for the triplets, and hours later, the first child showed symptoms. Hours after that, the second one showed symptoms, and by the end of the day, all three children had 'checked out' and went on to have a diagnosis of autism. You can clearly see that those three babies were absolutely bright-eyed and extremely well, healthy babies. So, that is a very important story for sure.

If people are listening or reading this and they think that delayed schedule is a good idea, you can't delay any more than that, and you can't delay any more than the MMR. You can't 'spit' those vaccines out – which is what my son had that day.

I have to tell you: Please don't think that delayed schedule is a good way forward. The parents around the world are screaming and warning you that it is not. Children are dead or injured from a delayed schedule.

Fitts: The other thing is that the doctors started to show up, and you have had amazing interviews with doctors as you were conferring with the parents.

Tommey: This really gave us hope and made us cry. Every time we had a highly qualified medical professional stepping onto the bus, hundreds of doctors came. *Vaxxed II* would capture some of those doctors, but there were many more doctors who came on that bus.

There was one who really impressed us who is a professor named Dr. Moss. He is extremely highly qualified. He came on the bus, and put on his suit jacket. I said, "You don't need to wear a suit jacket to do the interview."

He said, "But I do because tomorrow I probably won't have a job, and I want to go out in style."

It made us 'cry' because this man was so brave. Can you imagine if every doctor did that? Can you imagine if every doctor told the truth about the dangers of vaccines rather than collecting the money? Many, many doctors say, "I would love to do this, and I would love to stop vaccinating, but if I do that, Polly, I won't be able to put my kids through college. I won't be able to pay the mortgage. I won't be able to live the life that we are accustomed to."

I find that very hard to listen to because babies will die if you continue to vaccinate.

Fitts: Right, but I can't accept that excuse. I think that there is always a way, but there are certain lines that can't be crossed.

Recently Jon Rappoport said, "Every doctor in America is going to have to face a spiritual crisis, and here it is."

So the doctors went on the bus, and then you became overwhelmed by the death and by the destruction. You can see, especially with Gardasil, those beautiful young women absolutely destroyed or killed, and for no reason; there is absolutely no reason. I forget what the name of the one with the dark hair was. She explained that she was told that she might have cervical cancer, and you're thinking, "What?"

These are horrible stories. You became overwhelmed, and then you came up with an absolutely inspired idea. Tell us about your inspired idea, instead of doing the interviews with the unvaccinated.

Tommey: It was odd, because on the third trip on the bus, I realized that when we get to these stops, there were all of these families. I said, "Are you here to tell your story?"

Many of them would say, "No, we are just here to support you. We don't have any vaccines; we are not vaccinated."

He said, "I have no idea."

Then it was like 'a light bulb' moment. "Hang on! They are there for a reason! We are supposed to be listening to them. What is their life like? We are told – are we not? – that the unvaccinated are dangerous, they spread disease, and they could potentially kill us all. So, let's find out what is going on with them."

Once we opened the door to them, we got to the crux of the situation because we could tell as they came towards the bus that they were a vaccine-injured family, or they were unvaccinated. The unvaccinated were laughing, there was happiness, their eyes were bright, and these children were so radiant. It was incredible.

I think that the most interesting stories that we did on all of them were the families where you have two parents – a mother and a father – and they vaccinate the first child. The first child has injuries – either autism or whatever injuries – so they decide to delay the vaccines on the second child and give a delayed schedule. There is still injury, so then by the third child, they have had enough; they don't do any vaccines. They don't do any vitamin K or anything.

The difference between the children who are vaccinated and unvaccinated with the same parents and the same environment, and the same family is unbelievable. You suddenly realize, "That is why they are not allowing the vaccine studies to be published."

Fitts: That is what one of the researchers that you interviewed said. They said, "If the unvaccinated are allowed to stay unvaccinated, the parents will ultimately figure it out."

Tommey: Exactly. When we started doing the *Vaxxed* stories on the bus going live, that is when censorship stepped up; that is when we were kicked off of Facebook going live.

Fitts: Really?

Tommey: Yes, that is when we knew that this is what they don't want the world to see. So now instead of saying to the parents, "Do your research; Google vaccines," I don't say that anymore. It is all owned by big pharma.

Now I say, "If you want to do your research, speak to families that did vaccinate and then stopped. Keep going until you are satisfied because you will not believe the difference in the vaccinated versus the unvaccinated, and it will make your heart weep that you ever put a vaccine in yourself or your child."

As a parent of a vaccine-injured child – and all three of my children are vaccinated because I continued to vaccinate since I so believed and trusted the medical profession. Even after Billy (son) was injured, I still continued to vaccinate my new baby because who wants polio? I just didn't know.

So, I don't have a vaccine-free child. Each one of my children has either gut issues or something. My daughter has rheumatoid arthritis at age 25, which is not okay. That is a side effect of the MMR vaccine, by the way.

I just want to say that when we see these vaccine-free children, we are so happy for those families because some of them have listened to the stories and they are living a wonderful life. It is also a massive 'kick in the gut' that all three of my children could have been so much better – so much healthier and more focused. In the vaccine-free children, we don't have the problems that the vaccinated children have with focusing and understanding things. They are so bright.

There is a realization of what has happened and what we have done to our children.

Fitts: One way that *Vaxxed* saved my life – and I am going to talk money for a moment – is about a mother who is African-American and very well-spoken. She describes the fact that if you have a heavily autistic child, she estimated that it is going to cost \$5 million to provide for the education and care of that child.

It was very interesting because until I heard her, a 'light bulb' went off. I had so many wealthy clients who were grandparents. They would say to me, "I can't persuade my child not to vaccinate my grandchild. It's their decision; it's none of my business."

I started saying, "Wait a minute. Your child doesn't have \$5 million, but you do. So here is the thing: If your grandchild is vaccine-injured and becomes heavily autistic, you are out \$5 million. So, it is your business because you are the banker."

That was number one. But the other thing is that by going back and forth between the stories, and then what was happening with my clients who had the vaccine-injured children, I could calculate what the financial damage was. I could calculate what the damage was to the entire family's ecosystem – grandparents, parents, and siblings. It would radiate, and you could calculate financially and in human terms what the damage was, and it was unbelievable.

Then you ripple it through the community and the education system, and you are talking about the vaccine-injury epidemic being a financial tsunami that is going through this society. It was incredible.

Tommey: I don't know how future generations are going to be able to cope. Right now, it's bad. The tsunami has hit adults with autism brain injury beyond belief. But what is going to happen when we are gone? What is going to happen when the parents are all gone, and the siblings have all had breakdowns because they have lived it all their lives, and they are living with guilt and huge emotional problems? What is going to happen?

I see it already. I see them building psych hospitals where, unfortunately, it is going to be four-point restraints and medication, and that will be how they live their lives. That doesn't sit okay with me.

We recently had 40 acres donated in Austin, Texas, and we are building a center for adults with autism. We are going to film it, and we are going to show everybody how this is going to be done.

We as a human race have to look after these people who have been injured because their life as it should have been, has been taken away from them, and it is our duty to make sure that they are comfortable as they live out their life – not put them in fourpoint restraints. That is the only way that they are going to be able to deal with it all unless we start now.

Fitts: Once you did the comparison of the unvaccinated with the vaccinated, I started calculating financially– because you had several situations where you are talking about how much healthier the unvaccinated are, and how much more often the different parents are talking about their children's ear infections and so on. What you realize is that the vaccinations are harming an immune system sufficiently enough to create an annuity for the pharmaceutical companies for the next 60 years. It is extraordinary.

If you look at the present economic value of a vaccine-injured child versus a healthy child, to the pharmaceutical industry it's not only the business of vaccines, but it is the business of chronic disease. So, America also has an epidemic of chronic disease, and the profits from that are absolutely extraordinary – especially when you lever them in the stock market.

You see the unbelievable financial pressure to basically make America sick. That is the only way that I can describe it.

Tommey: I follow the money on everything. Let's take autism out of the equation for a moment. When we were looking at vaccinating these unvaccinated families, they don't even have the peanut allergies; they don't have eczema, asthma, or any of these things. It's goodbye big pharma when everyone stops vaccinating. We don't need them anymore because you heard these stories. Story after story after story, they say, "We don't see the doctors because we are never sick."

I will say one thing: When we were listening to the *Vaxxed* unvaccinated studies that are being done that aren't being published (but the results are out there, and if you want to find them you can find them), something wasn't adding up with us. We were like, "Hang on a minute. There are still unvaccinated people who are still sick with asthma and allergies. It's a very low percentage, but they are still there. We are not seeing that on the road."

So, we started changing our questioning. It turns out that the unvaccinated families that had the vitamin K at birth still had some sickness. We suddenly uncovered that vitamin K, which is not a vaccine and not classed as a vaccine, is causing a massive problem. So, we started calling them vaccine-free families without the vitamin K. These tended to be people who birthed at home, and their health was unbelievable. The vitamin K babies with no vaccines did have problems.

Many parents do not even know that their child had been given the vitamin K because the nurses just give that as soon as the baby is born. They tell you, "If you don't have this, your baby's brain will bleed, and it will die."

That is simply not true, and I urge parents to do their own research on vitamin K. Check out what is in there because it will horrify you.

Fitts: Is there an insert that comes with it? Can a parent get an insert on a vitamin K shot?

Tommey: There is an insert. In fact, I have a friend who is a doctor, and he just managed to get one for me, and they are hard to get. They will not want to give it to you. Many parents are told that if they don't give their baby vitamin K, they will not release them from the hospital. CPS (Child Protection Service) will be called, and they will possibly have their babies taken and forcibly given the vitamin K.

We are very early in finding out this information on the vitamin K, but the babies are much healthier without it. So, I urge parents to do whatever it takes to do their research on that themselves.

Fitts: One thing that you brought out in numerous interviews is the extent of the fear which is used to persuade, whether it was a young girl or a parent, to vaccinate their children. It was breathtaking. The bullying is extraordinary. So, a parent needs to be prepared and trained to deal with that kind of bullying because it is extreme.

You did a very good job of showing that.

Tommey: I want to say that on that note, personally as a mother to another mother who may be listening or reading this, if you think that you have a good relationship with your pediatrician, just watch what happens when you go in and question a vaccine. Your relationship will change. Don't expect that white coat pediatrician to give you the proper answers to your questions on vaccines. You will get things like, "Oh, there is no relationship between vaccines and autism at all. It was all made up by Dr. Andrew Wakefield. He is a fraud." You are going to get that.

You are going to get, "This is just mass hysteria from anti-vaxxers."

If someone is listening or reading this and says, "You are all crazy anti-vaxxers," please remember this: We all vaccinated our children. We are called 'ex-vaxxers'; we are not anti-vaxxers. Anti-vaxxers are clever people who did their research. We all vaccinated our children. So, slow down and think about what is being said to you in the media and by your doctors.

Fitts: I remember watching one interview of you when you said that you knew that at one point, you were very pro-vaccination. I thought, "What a journey to come from somebody who was very pro-vaccination."

Tommey: This is how pro-vaccine I was: When my little girl was in kindergarten, there was another mother there who did not vaccinate her children. She was taking them to India. We lived in England, and she was taking her children to India for the entire summer vacation unvaccinated. I actually went home and said to my husband, "Do you think that we should call Child Protective Services? Those children are going to die."

I was passionate that she was going to kill her children with no vaccines and taking her children to India. Luckily he said, "It's none of our business. Back off."

Otherwise, I would have done it because I truly believed that what she was doing was wrong. Of course, those children came back absolutely fine. I'm embarrassed to tell you that story, but I wanted you to know that I was so pro-vaccine. The whole thing is embarrassing, but for anyone listening or reading this who is the same as I used to be, please don't make the same mistakes that I have made.

Fitts: Something has happened. I am very interested in this, and this is true for all investment bankers. It is the field and when the field changes, and I am thinking more in terms of morphogenic fields.

Something happened, and I very much credit it to *Vaxxed* and now *Vaxxed II* and the bus trip. What has happened is: Imagine you are Polly or another parent like her. You are intelligent, you are successful, and this happens. You start to go through a process, and you can't believe that everything is a lie. You can't believe that the government, the medical profession, the corporations, and the media would all have bought into and be perpetrating a lie this big. It's too hard to fathom; it's too big. It's quite a journey to get to the point where you realize, "Okay. The whole process has very low integrity."

That is a big journey to get there, but when enough hard-working, responsible, intelligent people go through that process and get there and find each other, then something shifts; you can't be lied to anymore; you can't be bullied anymore; you can't be tricked anymore. You have the facts; the facts are real. You know them, and they have been corroborated by so many other people like you that you know the truth, and nobody and nothing can take it away – no matter how much they bully or lie or how much money or power they have.

That shift has now happened. I think with vaccines, it is the first time in 100 years that this has happened.

Tommey: First of all, if you hurt our babies, we are mothers and we hold our beautiful babies in our arms. The first thing that we say to ourselves mentally is, "No one is ever going to hurt this baby."

When you hurt a baby, we are all going to react. Thanks to social media, we have this power where we can come together as one big family because we are all in pain. We are all passionate about stopping other people.

Those numbers are growing and growing and growing. They are trying to censor us every single day; they are trying to put us down.

Even with this coronavirus situation right now, we have had to cancel the bus tour and all the film festivals that *Vaxxed II: The People's Truth* was in. I know coronavirus is for real, and I get it, but I will say this: It is a very clever way of stopping many people who are – in their government's mind – 'out of control', and getting together and getting stronger and stronger. We are all cut off right now, and we are censored on social media.

But it doesn't matter how many times you do that because the people are the people. When the people say, "No, you don't touch my family, and you don't touch my child," then it's game over.

And when they come out with this new vaccine and say, "It is mandatory. Everyone has to have it," you watch what our people do. We are a very big, strong, worldwide family now, and over our dead bodies will these vaccines be coming into our babies or ourselves; we are done.

I think that it is going to be over fairly soon. It has to be. But you have to remember one thing that is very important: What is going to happen when people wake up and stop vaccinating? Possibly there are going to be some injuries from it, and they are going to blame the anti-vaxxers. Here is the problem: The vaccine makers have taken away our natural immunity.

When I was a child, my mother took me to get measles, mumps, rubella, and chicken pox – all those childhood illnesses. We went to parties and share lollipop suckers and passed it around so we all caught it. It wasn't that easy. We would be very disappointed if we hadn't caught the measles and we would have to go to another 'party', but it was done for a reason. Boys especially had to get mumps before puberty set in. We had it under control, and that has gone.

For that reason, we are going to have to let nature put itself back in order. I don't know how many years that is going to take, but it is going to be okay if we get through that. There is no vaccine on Earth worth risking anything – your job, your school, your state, your house, or whatever you think it is that is so important to put that vaccine into your child – if your child dies from it or your child gets injured like my child.

Many people now because of vaccines, are not able to have babies. Take my son for example, who has autism, and he is never going to be able to get married and have children because of the level of autism that he has. You have the Gardasil girls who have gone through menopause at age 16. They will never have children. You have children who are paralyzed from the waist down. There are many children in wheelchairs from these vaccines as well. They will never have children.

So, do you see what is happening? Girls in general are finding it very hard to get pregnant. We are not seeing that in the girls who are vaccine-free. There is a really big problem there as well.

Fitts: I hope you are right about the tipping point. The first day of the coronavirus I said, "Our problem is not the virus; our problem is going to be the vaccine they try to use to push on us."

As you know, they are pushing vaccine mandates all around the country in the United States and all around the world. China adopted a national vaccine mandate in December 2019, right before the coronavirus started.

This is a battle that is coming down to every state and house, and it has become very extreme. One of the people we have had on *The Solari Report* several times is Alan Phillips, and he was recently disbarred because he refused to turn over his client files to the Bar association. He was representing families who wanted exemptions in a variety of different states.

This fight is turning very mean. I know that you have been involved, but have you been involved with some of the fights at the state legislature?

Tommey: Yes. On the first *Vaxxed* film I would go around with Andy and Del to the politicians, but I called a politician out for taking pharmaceutical money, and then I had to publicly apologize. So, they decided that I wasn't suitable to be around politicians, which is fine by me, I will stick to the families. I don't get along very well with politicians.

They do all take pharmaceutical money, and this particular politician said to me, "Why would I be any different from any other politician?"

I don't understand the conflicts of interest that are around. I say this to everybody: Please follow the money with the politicians. It is quite incredible how big pharma practically rules the world.

Fitts: If you look at how much money they put into the media pockets, it's incredible. The other thing that really scares people is that they are very effective at bullying you personally in a variety of ways or arranging for you to be bullied. It is quite extraordinary. I've had a couple of experiences where somebody turned up and started bullying, and I could tell that they had been given a 'mission': 'I'm to give a message."

It is extraordinary and very, very invasive. One of the things that makes me ask all the time is: What in the world are they really putting in this 'stuff'?

I'm sure that you have seen the excerpts from the Vaccine Summit in Switzerland in December. I only watched the excerpts. Del Bigtree (anti-vaccination activist) did a video where he put his commentary between various excerpts. It certainly looked as though the pushback of the parents and the doctors had reached enough of a place where you literally had the program heads in the different countries saying, "We don't have any studies that prove that these are safe and effective individually, let alone when you put them all together in one small body."

Just watching those excerpts, it looked as though the global vaccine program had stalled.

Tommey: I think the problem is that the general public has people like us who listen to the media outside of the pharmaceutical media, and there are many of us doing that now. Most of us have turned off our mainstream televisions and are listening to the real things that are going on by interviews like the ones you do. Unfortunately, the majority of people still turn on their TVs and listen to CNN or the doctors and they believe it. These are the people who we need to convince. That is really the crux of what has happened behind *Vaxxed II*; it was meant for those people. It was meant for those young people who think they can get vaccines to get into college because, "That's not going to happen to me. I'm not going to get autism, so it doesn't matter."

We want to tell them, "Do you know that you can die from a vaccine? Did you know that?" They don't. No one has a clue because we are so brainwashed; if it's on TV, it must be correct; if it's on a billboard, it must be true. "They wouldn't put it on a billboard if it wasn't true."

That used to be the way I thought, so I do get it.

Fitts: One of the things that you make clear in *Vaxxed II* is that you are learning a great deal You had no idea the depth and breadth of the problem. Please say a few words from the moment you bought the bus until you finished with all 7,044 signatures on the bus, what you learned.

Tommey: I learned that every single vaccine has a terrible issue attached to it. I learned about vaccines that I didn't even know existed. I learned about the bullying from the doctors to the parents about what would happen if you don't get this vaccine. I learned how easily we all are bullied and brainwashed.

The most important thing of all that I learned is: Thanks to the unvaccinated, you can have a healthy life like you are supposed to, and you can stand up to these doctors and say, "No. This is my child. You do not touch them."

These families showed me how it should have been, and that we shouldn't be afraid, and that we don't have to go to hospitals and give birth if you are having a perfectly normal pregnancy. In the early days, nobody went to hospitals and gave birth.

It was really a massive education from these vaccine-free families of how it should have been. I learned everything in the last four years since *Vaxxed I*. I learned more from the parents, and I urge everyone to please speak to the parents. Don't only speak to one; speak to hundreds.

Or listen to all of our Periscope videos; go to the Roku channel, and you can hear them all.

Fitts: They can listen to all of the interviews, right?

Tommey: Yes. People say to me, "Polly, it's not real. You chose these people."

I had no idea who would show up. Every day I would wake up on the bus, and I would have a schedule of where I was going. I would turn up there, and there would be lines of people I had never met in my life.

The critics said, "You made this film, and you put in the ones that you thought would make a good story."

I cannot tell you how there are hundreds and hundreds of those stories that are all the same. If we had a death from any of these illnesses that we vaccinate for, that story would have been in *Vaxxed II* because that story is as important as the child who died from the vaccine of measles. However, we can't find any; we have been asking and calling out: If there is anyone who has a family member of any age or generation that died from measles, we have to hear that story. No one even knows anybody.

Fitts: As you went along, did you deal with the corporate media at all? Did you have to deal with their bullying at all?

Tommey: Actually, the worst media of all was in England. We had a couple of reporters turn up following the bus. They got onto the bus to interview, and it was all about Andrew Wakefield. "Andrew Wakefield is crazy, and you are all brainwashed. All of you are brainwashed by Andrew Wakefield."

None of us had even heard of Andrew Wakefield when we had our babies vaccinated. Even the new people with their newly vaccinated babies would come on the bus and say, "We don't even know who Andrew Wakefield is." They had never even watched *Vaxxed*; they just knew that there was this black bus going around where they could go and report their injuries.

We did have a few people shout, "Hope your child dies from the measles," and terrible things like that. But the worst bullying that we get is online. I think that they are paid pharmaceutical trolls.

Fitts: They are paid.

Tommey: They say terrible things and hope they break you down. To start with, it's a shock and it's upsetting. They say horrible things about your family. They might even try to contact you. I've had my children contacted with terrible things about their mother. But you know that they are just there to break you down, and you will win this.

If you are telling the truth – which I am with my son's story and all these other parents are as well – then the truth will win. It has to win, and it will win.

Fitts: Right, it will.

Before the travel restrictions shut you down, what were you doing with the bus? What is the post-*Vaxxed II* bus doing?

Tommey: We went straight back out on tour, and the stories went up a notch. Now we are seeing many more adults coming out talking about their injuries following adult vaccines. That is 'oh-so-horrific'. These are healthcare workers who needed a series of Hepatitis B who now can't walk or have spasms and they can't work anymore. These are firefighters and paramedics and all these people who now can't do their job because the Hep B in adults has actually prevented them from being able to work or do anything like that. The meningitis and flu vaccines have caused horrific injuries everywhere. So, it's really interesting that now it is coming out with the adults, and, of course, there is death everywhere.

Many parents are telling us that their parents (the grandparents) had the flu vaccine and then died. So, there are many deaths and injuries from these adult vaccines. That is what is happening.

We were just about ready to return to Utah because the bus is parked there. However, because of the coronavirus, the film festival and all of our stops have been cancelled – which is fine. We will sit back and wait, and then we will go back out on tour.

Then we will deal with the coronavirus vaccines.

Fitts: Can you do interviews online?

Tommey: We can, but I much prefer to be there in person because they need big hugs afterwards. I feel that it doesn't seem as personal, and I really need to be close to them. It is very traumatic having to go back and tell the story of what happened. Many people are not talking about it because they are told that they are crazy. When they sit down on the bus, it is an emotional place to be. If you get a chance to see the bus, as you go towards it, you will cry. There are now 9,400 names on that bus.

Fitts: You are up to 9,400. Wow!

Tommey: Inside the bus there are many, many pictures of people who have died following vaccines. You step into that bus, and you see all that, and it is very emotional. There is a profusion of tears.

It is also a safe haven people to talk. So, the bus will continue as soon as this craziness is over with the coronavirus, and we will be back out on the road.

AutismOne is our next big event. It is in May, and we are hoping that it doesn't get cancelled because it is a wonderful place for everyone to go. You don't have to have an autistic child; you can just go there and meet hundreds and hundreds and hundreds of people who have had the same story as you if you vaccinated your child.

Fitts: The things that everybody can do is to buy the DVD and screen the film, explore all the different videos and interviews that you have on your channels, and then they can recommend it and spread it around. If somebody is interested in a screening, can they contact you through the website to arrange a screening?

Tommey: You can, but nothing is going to happen in theatres at the moment because most theatres have censors, and they will not let us show it. AMC theatres were showing our films, but they have now been put under too much pressure; they have been culled. So, there are very few theatres now letting us play the film.

That should say something to you all if you are listening or reading this and thinking, "This is nonsense."

Why would they censor this film if it's nonsense? They are censoring it because it is the truth. There are many nonsense films that are playing in theatres, and they are allowed to play, but they don't want you to hear the truth.

Fitts: It's interesting. We just published two interviews – one with Jon Rappoport and the coronavirus and the risk of a vaccine, and another with Mary Holland who is the vice chairman of Children's Defense Fund on vaccine mandates. We put up three-minute excerpts in video form that were posted on Vimeo, and Vimeo spiked both of them.

They essentially said that Mary Holland was saying fraudulent things.

Tommey: There is no one more interrogated in the world than Mary Holland. That is why we set up our own channel, and it took us three years to build it. Thank goodness for clever people in our movement! That is why we have our own channel, so that they can't touch us. It is called Peeps TV because we can't call it anything intelligent; we have to hide it under a name like Peeps TV.

The people came up with that idea. But please go there and check it out. If you have a film that has been banned, we will play it for you on that. Just contact us if you have any story or film that has been taken off. We will play it on our channel.

Fitts: So, we can sign up for your channel, we can buy the DVD, we can get other people to watch it, and we can spread it. How can we support you? Can we donate at the site?

Tommey: Yes. If you go to <u>www.VaxxedII.com</u>, there is a 'donate' button. Those funds will go towards the gas for the bus, which costs \$120 every 300 miles. It's a big old bus. For that, we are very grateful for any gas support.

Otherwise, people are very good; they carry us and they feed us. It is just a wonderful group. It restores your faith in humanity. I will tell you this: America has some amazing people in it; there are amazing people in America. I've never felt such love from people.

Fitts: Yes, and we can sign up for your email. You have an email update, correct?

Tommey: Yes, you can sign up. When we get alerts on anything, we will let you know as well. The way that censorship is going, we should all try to stay together as much as possible. I can't even get on Facebook anymore; they have banned me.

'It is what it is'.

Fitts: We will post this. Normally, our interviews are subscriber-only, but this one is going to be public, so we will let you know when it's public. We will send it out to our full email list.

Polly, if there is anything that we can ever do, we brought up our own video server, so we can post videos.

Tommey: They can't stop the people. It's the people's truth, and we are getting bigger and more powerful.

Join us, people. Let's end this barbaric-ness in the world.

Fitts: The hardest thing for me in watching *Vaxxed II* is every time I dip into this topic, I realize how extraordinarily barbaric it is. I used to have a pastor who would say, "If we can face it, God can fix it."

I think that is why it is so unbelievable and it is so hard to face how barbaric it is, but it is so important to face it. I really appreciate how you have brought that out without making it too unbearable. I think that you did a great job in *Vaxxed II* of doing that. 'Barbaric' is the perfect word.
